

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) has issued a Notice of Intent to issue a Preliminary Environmental Impacts Determination (PEID) to the Village of Berkeley. The Village has applied to the IEPA Public Water Supply Loan Program to request funding to help finance lead service line replacement projects.

A Project Summary and PEID document provided by the IEPA is available for review on the Village's website, www.berkeley.il.us, and at Village Hall at 5819 Electric Ave, Berkeley, IL 60163. The document contains the project locations, descriptions, costs, environmental impacts, and other information. A Public Hearing has been scheduled at the Village Hall on Thursday, April 2, 2024 from 5:00pm to 6:00pm to present and receive comments on the proposed projects and PEID.

This Notice is to provide access to the document and notification of the scheduled Public Hearing to satisfy Sections 663.330 of the Illinois Procedures for Issuing Loans from the Public Water Supply Loan Program. These documents will be on the website and on file at the Village Hall prior to the Public Hearing and for 10 days after the hearing date to allow for public comment on the proposed projects. Public comments will be accepted until 5:00pm on Friday, April 12, 2024 and may be addressed in writing to either:
